



## Tallinn Private 1-DAY SIGHTSEEING TOUR (approx. 5 Hrs)

Enjoy Tallinn during a comprehensive, panoramic Tour of the city's History, Architecture and Culture with a Private Guide. You'll be picked up by your personal highly qualified English speaking Guide/Driver next to your ship with a state-of-the-art, smoke-free and air-conditioned Vehicle.

**Should your ship arrive later than scheduled, your Guide/Driver will always wait for you!**

**8:30 AM. - At the Pier – Guide/Driver will hold a Sign with Your Name on it.**

Your safety is our Paramount - therefore, please don't leave the pier with any other driver than the one holding your sign.

**The 5 Hrs. tour consists of 3 parts: (No entrances included)**

- **Old Town** - 2 Hrs. walking tour
- **Tallinn and surroundings** – 1.5 Hrs. panoramic sightseeing tour.
- **A Short visit Synagogue and Jewish Museum (NOT a Guided Tour)**
- **Free Time**

**Activity level: Driving, medium walking, few steps to take.**

**08:30 AM** Start from the pier.

- **“Old Town” walking tour** guided in English begins with in the **Upper Town** - Toompea (Castle Hill) where the walking tour starts. First to be seen is the Toompea castle, where the Estonian Government as well as Parliament are seated. On Toompea is also the tallest tower, Pikk Hermann - the symbol of political power of Estonia; the flag at its top has always belonged to the masters of the land.
- **The city sightseeing tour** guided in English covers the whole of the city centre and introduces you the city's most interesting sights and attractions. During the city sightseeing tour the guests are to the landmarks of Tallinn architecture: Russalka monument, Kadriorg Park, art museum KUMU, residence of the President, Maarjamäe, St Birgitta cloister ruins, Olympic centre and Pirita Beach
- **A Short visit Synagogue and Jewish Museum (NOT a Guided Tour)**

**- Coffee Break, and a short stop for shopping opportunity**

**1 PM** - Drive back to the pier

**1:30 PM** - Return on board
